
## Getting Started with Gnowee

## Getting Started – How does Gnowee work?

- **Register Your Interest** in receiving a Gnowee USB card by:
  - [www.gnowee.net](http://www.gnowee.net), or
  - Speaking with your local Cellestis representative
- **Register for Access** through Gnowee USB card
  - Must be connected to internet for this initial registration
  - Must have Adobe AIR program installed
- **Log-in** after your initial registration anytime using either:
  - USB card (offline), or
  - [www.gnowee.net](http://www.gnowee.net) (online)

# Getting Started - Register Your Interest

- Go to [www.gnowee.net](http://www.gnowee.net), complete the fields, click “Register.”

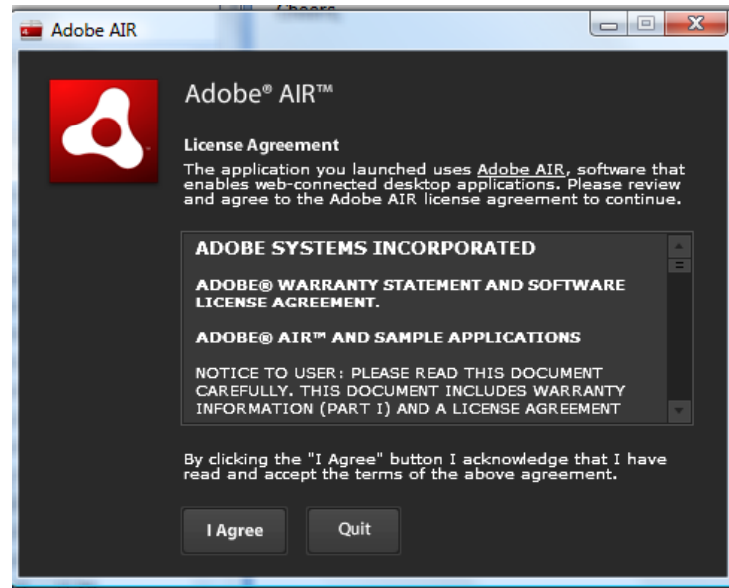

# Register for Access – Download AIR

- When you receive a Gnowee USB card, what do you do?
  - Download Adobe AIR program (needs to be installed before your computer can utilize Gnowee)
    - AIR download should be automatic or one-click.
    - If you do not already have the AIR (like Flash) on your computer, the Adobe AIR Installer should automatically pop up and ask you to install. You might see a pop-up window like this. Click “I agree.”



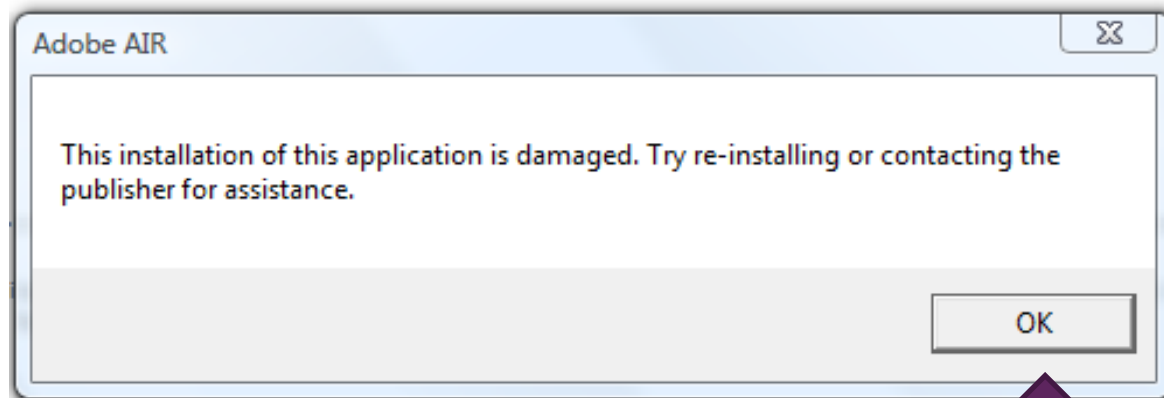
# Register for Access – Upgrade AIR

If you have an outdated version of AIR on your computer, you will be automatically asked to upgrade your version of AIR. You might see a pop-up window like this. Click “Update Now.”



## Register for Access – AIR troubleshoot

- If AIR download is not successful (see error message below), what do you do? There are a couple of options.



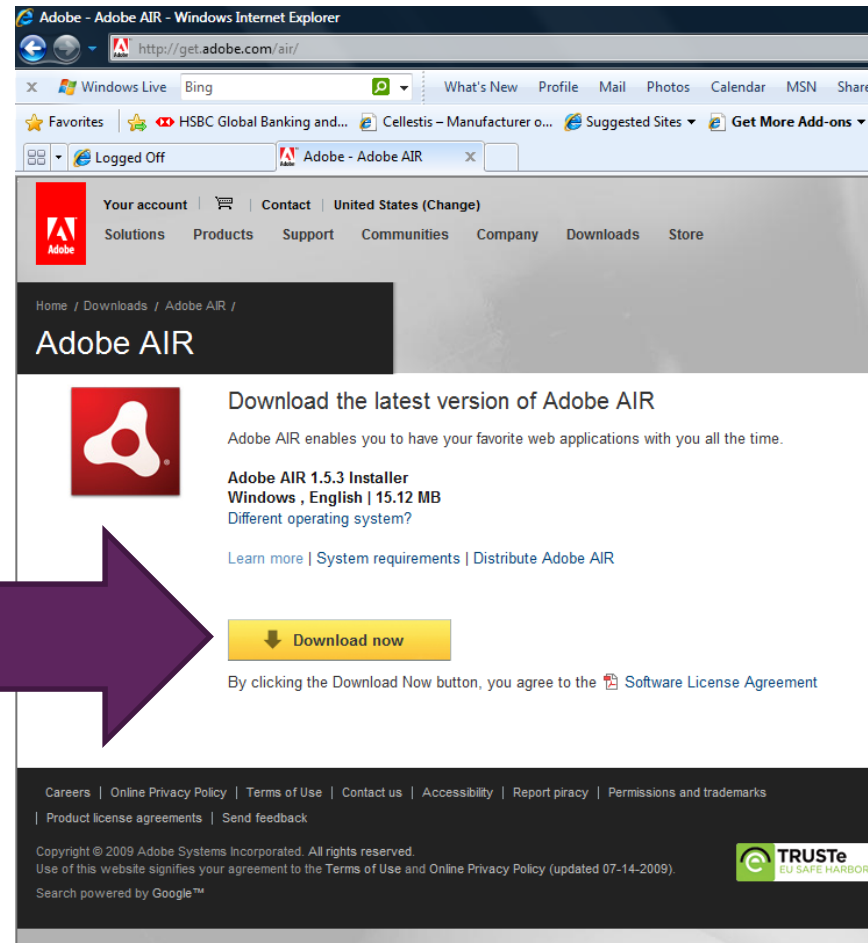
Click OK on error message

## Option 1: Web download

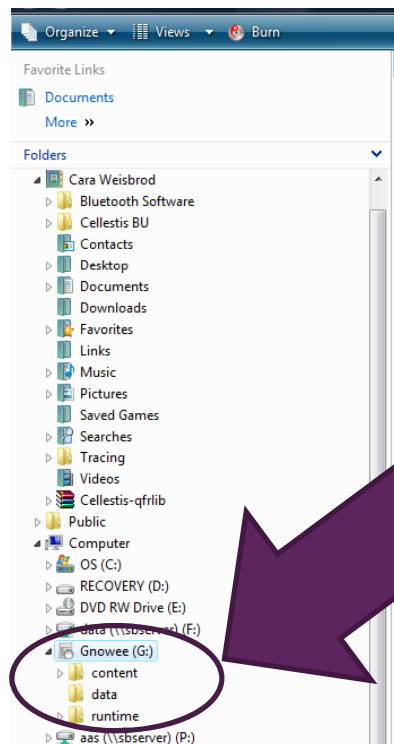
1. Go to internet browser and type in <http://get.adobe.com/air/>
2. Click “Download Now.”



# Register for Access – AIR troubleshoot

## Option 2: Manual download

1. Go to your file explorer and select Gnowee drive (example G: drive)
2. Select “AdobeAIRInstaller” application file.

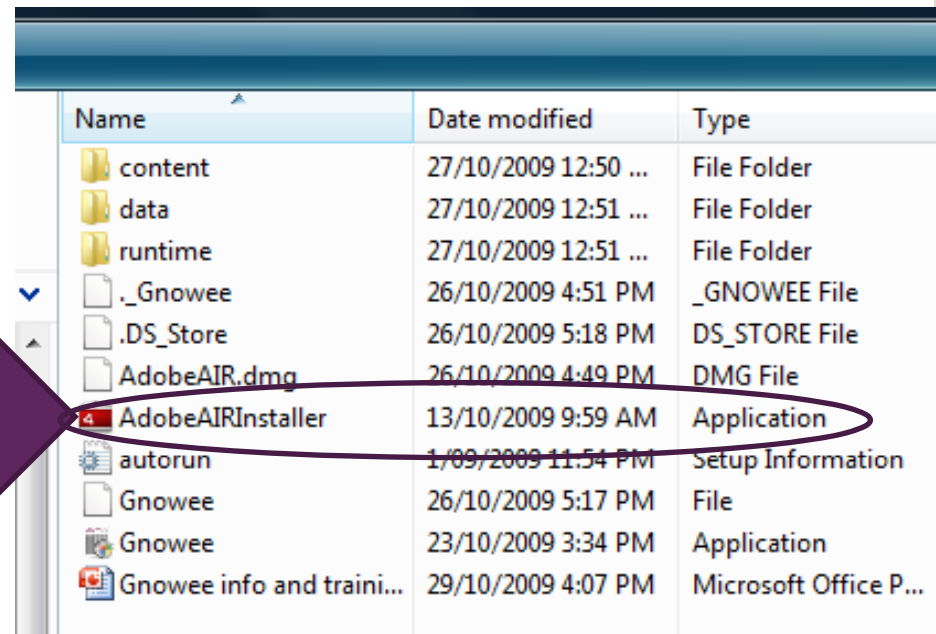
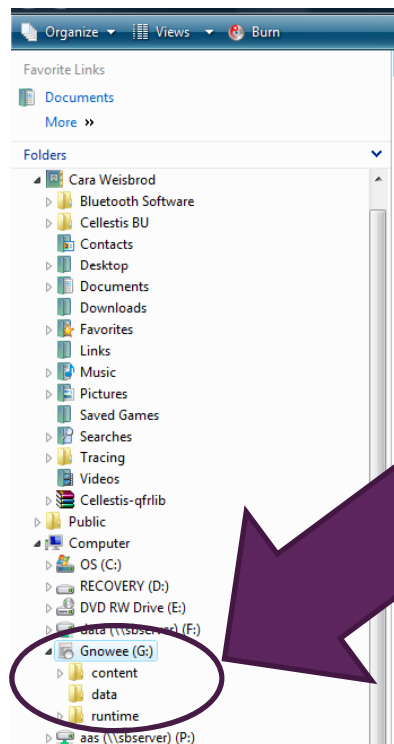

# Register for Access – AIR troubleshoot


## Option 2: Manual download

1. Go to your file explorer and select Gnowee drive (example G: drive)
2. Select “AdobeAIRInstaller” application file and download AIR



# Register for Access - Enter Details

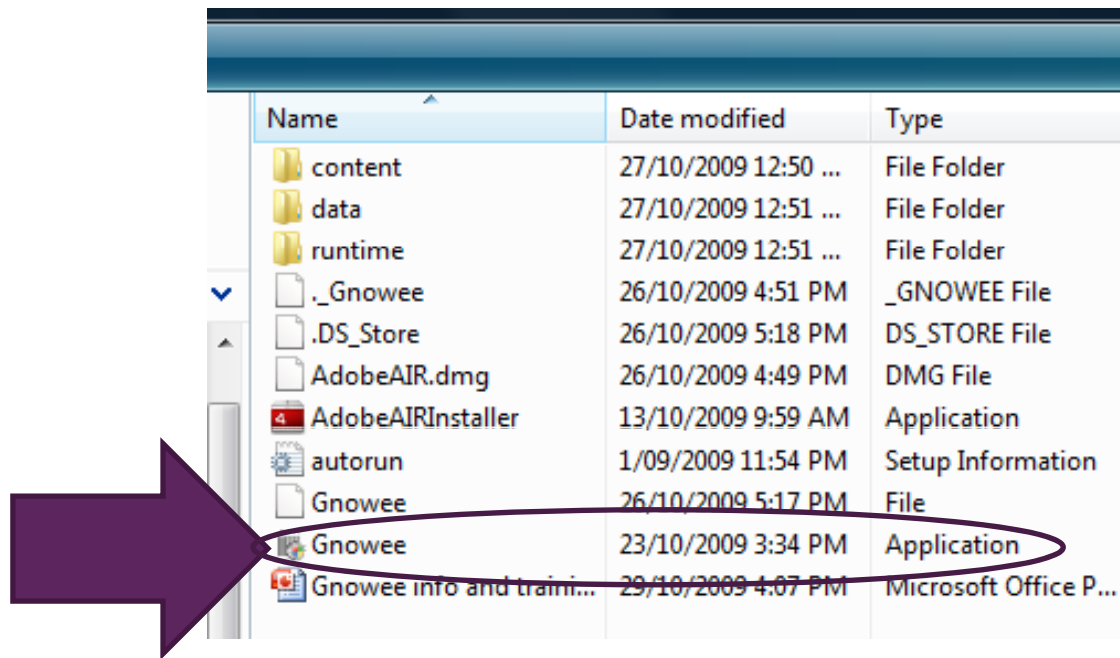
- Once AIR is downloaded, this registration screen should automatically pop up.
- Make sure you have an active internet connection.
- Enter your details and click “Submit.”

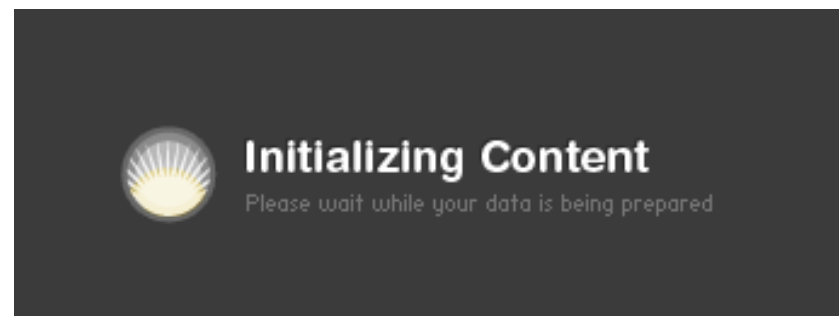
## Register for Access - Enter Details

- If the registration screen doesn't automatically pop up, you may need to go to your explorer window and select the Gnowee application file manually.



## Initial Registration - Initialization

- After your initial registration, you will see a window with the software terms of use. Once accepted, this window will not automatically appear again, but you can access this information in the “Help” screen in Gnowee.
- After your initial registration and after every subsequent log-in, you will see the Initialization screen (below). This means that the information in Gnowee is being accessed for you.
- Please note that the speed of your computer will determine the length of initialization.



# Initial Registration – Automatic Update

- Every time you **(a)** log-in through the USB card and **(b)** are connected to the internet, Gnowee will automatically search to see if there is new material that can be added to your USB card

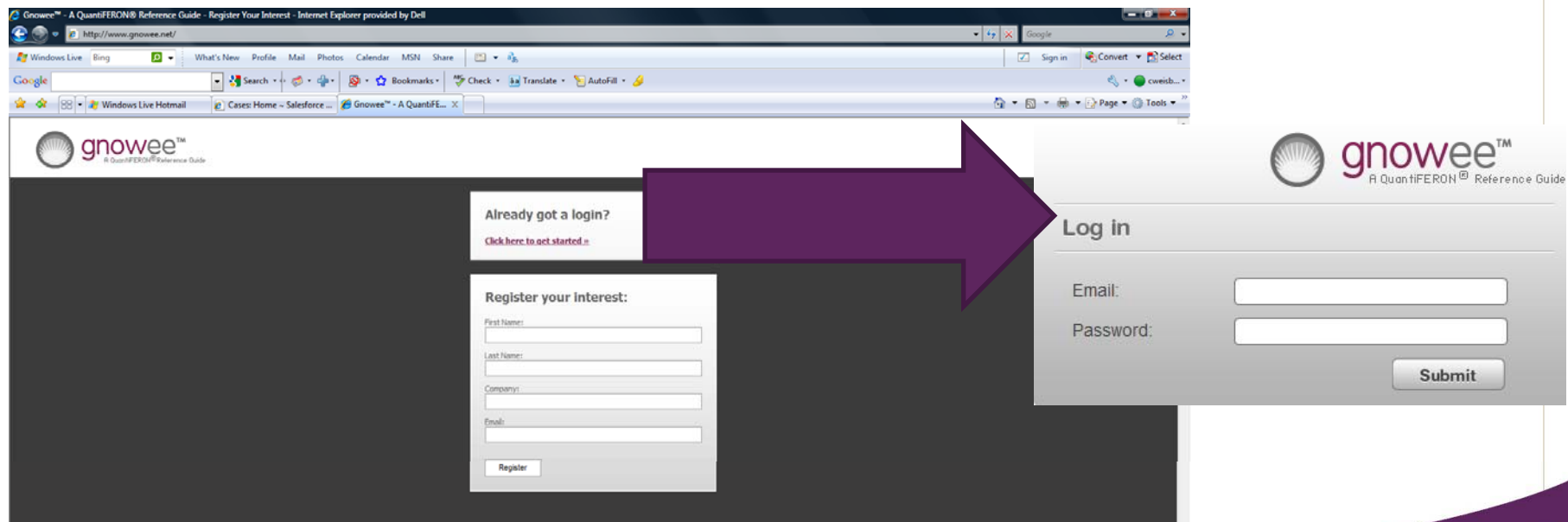
